



Wakatipu Potters Group is a not-for-profit community pottery club. We have been in existence since 1982 and are located at 50 Stanley Street Queenstown, at the corner of Stanley and Ballarat Streets, inside the Queenstown Art Society building.

Visitor Open Nights

6pm – 8pm every Wednesday (excluding the months of December, January) year round. A donation of \$10pp is required for a two hour session in our studio facilities, with our volunteer members providing help and instruction, and clay. There is a \$15 fee for anyone who wishes to learn to throw potter on a wheel. If a visitor wishes to fire anything, the cost is \$5 per piece (2 firings).

Visitor Nights are open to visitors and locals of all ages (under 6 not permitted). Children 6 - 16 must be attended with parent or guardian.

Space is limited on Visitor Nights. It is a small studio, so first in/first served.

Any visitor who attends our club nights for at least five sessions is welcome to apply to join our club as a permanent member for an annual fee and can then use our pottery studio on a 24/7 basis.
